The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the July 18, 2019 filing ("Filing") by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) proposing to set the Electric Service Schedule No. 94 – Energy Balancing Account (EBA) Pilot Program ("Schedule 94") collection rates on Sheet No. 94.11 to zero, effective August 1, 2019. RMP represents the Filing addresses a recent Utah Supreme Court decision pertaining to the EBA and that the Division of Public Utilities (DPU), the Office of Consumer Services, the Utah Association of Energy Users, and Utah Industrial Energy Consumers support RMP's proposal.

On July 23, 2019, the DPU filed comments recommending the PSC approve the Filing.

Based on the PSC's review of RMP's Filing and the recommendations of the DPU, the changes to Sheet No. 94.11 are approved as filed, effective August 1, 2019.
