Pursuant to Utah Code § 54-10a-301 and UTAH ADMIN. CODE r. 746-1, the Office of Consumer Services (“OCS”) hereby moves the Public Service Commission of Utah for an order allowing the OCS’s out of state witness Donna Ramas to testify telephonically at the March 5, 2020 hearing on Rocky Mountain Power’s (“RMP”) proposed test year. Only the OCS and the Division of Public Utilities filed testimony in this matter and both parties support RMP’s proposed test year. The expense of flying Ms. Ramas to Utah to testify in person is unjustified given that the central issue in the hearing will be uncontested. Counsel for the OCS has contacted all parties to this docket and can represent that no party objects to this Motion. Because the date of the hearing occurs before the normal briefing period is concluded, the OCS requests expedited treatment for this Motion.
