On May 28, 2020, the Public Service Commission (PSC) held a telephonic scheduling conference in these dockets. ## **DISCOVERY**

The Participants did not agree unanimously as to the number of days RMP should be allowed to respond to informal discovery requests. The disagreement only pertained to the GRC

Docket and was further limited solely to the turnaround time through the date this order requires parties other than RMP to file their direct testimony. RMP argues, consistent with prior general rate cases, that 21 days is appropriate. UAE argues this period is too long and that the PSC should require RMP to respond in 14 days consistent with scheduling orders in other jurisdictions. RMP counters that Utah has extensive filing requirements that obviate the need for much of the preliminary discovery conducted in such jurisdictions and leads to initial discovery requests in Utah being relatively more sophisticated and burdensome to answer. The OCS stated it agreed with UAE but offered no additional argument in support. The DPU represented it had no objection to RMP's proposed 21-day turnaround.

Having considered the Participants' positions, the PSC concludes that maintaining the 21-day period for responding to these early requests is reasonable and appropriate in light of Utah's filing requirements. Accordingly, discovery turn-around times shall be as follows:

- With respect to the GRC Docket, Phase I Cost of Capital, 21 calendar days until
   August 20, 2020; 14 calendar days from that date through September 17, 2020; and 7
   calendar days thereafter.
- 2. With respect to the GRC Docket, Phase I Revenue Requirement, 21 calendar days until September 2, 2020; 14 calendar days from that date until October 5, 2020; and 7 calendar days thereafter.
- 3. With respect to the GRC Docket, Phase II Cost of Service/Pricing 21 calendar days until September 15, 2020; 14 calendar days from that date until October 16, 2020; and 7 calendar days thereafter.

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4. With respect to the Depreciation Docket, 14 calendar days until September 2, 2020; 10 calendar days from that date until October 5, 2020; and 7 calendar days thereafter.

Parties shall serve discovery requests and responses on applicable parties by email. In the event a document produced in response to a discovery request cannot reasonably be transmitted by email, the party disclosing the document shall provide an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy).
