The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the compliance filing ("Filing") filed by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) on November 6, 2020 pursuant to the PSC's August 25, 2009 Order Granting Approval of Phase I Stipulation in Docket No. 09-035-T08 ("Order").<sup>1</sup> In the Filing RMP notified the PSC that as of September 2020 year-to-date expenditures for the Home Energy Reports Program ("Program") totaled \$794,949. According to RMP, this expenditure level exceeded 90 percent of the 2020 forecast for the Program and is due to opening the Program to any customer with an email address on file resulting in over 100,000 additional customers receiving reports.

DPU recommended the PSC acknowledge the Filing as complying with the Order. According to DPU the Program's initial forecast of \$850,080 has been updated to \$1,094,949.

Based on the PSC's review of the Filing and on DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges the Filing as complying with the PSC's Order.
