Dear Mr. Snow:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the Annual Demand-Side Management (DSM) Deferred Account and Forecast Report and associated Attachments 1 through 4 ("Report") filed by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) on November 2, 2020. The PSC also reviewed comments filed by the Utah Division of Public Utilities (DPU) and Utah Clean Energy/Southwest Energy Efficiency Project (UCE/SWEEP), and RMP's reply comments.

DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Report as complying with PSC orders in Docket Nos. 09-035-T08 and 10-035-57. UCE/SWEEP asks that we direct RMP to work with the DSM Steering Committee to develop a modified DSM procurement plan in 2021. Though RMP addressed UCE /SWEEP's concerns in its reply comments, the process will continue to benefit from a robust discussion of RMP's chosen Class 2 DSM resource mix between RMP and the DSM Steering Committee.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and revised Attachment 1, the filed comments and recommendations, and RMP's reply comments, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with the relevant reporting requirements.
