Rocky Mountain Power’s Notice of Intent to File a Proposed Charging Infrastructure Program with the Public Service Commission of Utah	<u>DOCKET NO. 20-035-34</u> <u>NOTICE</u>
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ISSUED: August 28, 2020

Governor Herbert signed House Bill 396, Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure Amendments (“HB 396”), into law on March 28, 2020. HB 396 is codified at Utah Code Ann. § 54-4-41 and authorizes a large-scale electric utility company to petition the Public Service Commission (PSC) for approval of a program to facilitate electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure and service in the State of Utah. The law requires a large-scale electric utility company, prior to submitting the proposed EV charging infrastructure program to the PSC for approval, to seek and consider input from a number of state agencies, third-party EV battery charging service operators, and “any other person who files a request for notice” with the PSC. Utah Code Ann. § 54-4-41(3).

On August 27, 2020, PacifiCorp, doing business in Utah as Rocky Mountain Power (RMP), filed its Notice of Intent to File a Proposed Charging Infrastructure Program with the PSC (“Notice”). In the Notice, RMP states it is in the early stages of developing a proposed charging infrastructure program (“Proposed Program”) and anticipates filing it with the PSC on or around December 31, 2020. RMP further states it will hold a stakeholder input meeting on September 24, 2020 to seek input regarding the Proposed Program and requests the PSC issue a notice to allow any interested parties an opportunity to file a request for notice with the PSC, indicating their desire to provide input on RMP’s Proposed Program. The PSC previously received two such requests for notice under Utah Code Ann. § 54-4-41(3)(j) from Western

Resource Advocates and Utah Clean Energy on July 29, 2020 and August 27, 2020, respectively.

The PSC gives notice that other parties that would like to provide input for this initial stakeholder meeting may file a request for notice with the PSC under Utah Code Ann. § 54-4-41(3)(j) on or before **Friday, September 18, 2020**.
