Dear Ms. Saba:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the March 11, 2020 filing by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP), proposing changes to Electric Service Schedule No. 94, Energy Balancing Account (EBA), Sheet No. 94.11 (“Compliance Filing”). The Compliance Filing was made pursuant to the PSC’s Order Approving Rates and Granting Unopposed Motion to Vacate Orders issued on March 4, 2020, and updates the EBA rates to collect the remaining \$17.3 million balance of deferred EBA costs approved in Docket No. 19-035-01.

The PSC also reviewed the March 23, 2020 filing by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) recommending the PSC approve RMP’s proposed changes to Sheet No. 94.11 as filed, effective April 1, 2020. DPU states it reviewed the workpapers included in the filing and believes they support RMP’s proposed revisions.

Based on the PSC’s review of the filing and DPU’s comments, the proposed revisions to Schedule 94, Sheet No. 94.11 are approved, effective April 1, 2020.
