The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Moon Lake Electric Cooperative Association's ("MLEA") September 14, 2021 filing of its Wildland Fire Protection Plan Compliance Report ("Report"). The Report documents the implementation of the Wildland Fire Protection Plan (WFPP) originally filed on July 13, 2020 pursuant to Utah Code Title 54, Chapter 24, Wildland Fire Planning and Cost Recovery Act ("Act"). Specifically, the Report lists MLEA's progress made in addressing action items listed in its WFPP, and contains a description of actions taken in 13 high-risk areas to mitigate the risks associated with wildfires and reduce the probability of wildfire initiation due to the generation and transmission of electricity by MLEA.

The PSC also reviewed the October 14, 2021 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). DPU recommends that the PSC acknowledge that the Report complies with Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(4)(b).

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(4)(b). Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(5), the Report is available for public inspection at the PSC.
