On December 30, 2020, in Docket No. 20-035-04, *In the Matter of the Application of Rocky Mountain Power for Authority to Increase its Retail Electric Utility Service Rates in Utah and for Approval of its Proposed Electric Service Schedules and Electric Service Regulations*, the Commission approved a balancing account to true-up pension settlement adjustments.
