Dear Mr. Viner:

I am providing the following in response to your e-mail request for information pertaining to PacifiCorp's Blue Sky Program. PacifiCorp does business in Utah as Rocky Mountain Power (RMP). The Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) approved RMP's Blue Sky Program and requires RMP to file an annual report on the Blue Sky Program. This report is reviewed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU), a state agency, and other interested parties. RMP's 2019 Annual Report of the Blue Sky Program for the period of January 1 through December 31, 2019 (filed on March 26, 2020), the DPU comments on the 2019 Annual Report, RMP's reply comments, the PSC's letter acknowledging the 2019 Annual Report, and DPU's review and audit of PacifiCorp's 2019 Blue Sky Program dated September 24, 2020 can be found at the following link: <https://psc.utah.gov/2020/03/26/docket-no-20-035-16/>

In its comments on the 2019 Annual Report of the Blue Sky Program, the DPU stated the 2019 Annual Report "substantially complies with [PSC] Orders and adheres to the [PSC]'s reporting requirements. [DPU] contacted [RMP] in reference to the missing reporting requirements [related to the Blue Sky Build Program]. [RMP] stated that there were 16 applications received and of those 16, 6 were declined. [RMP] intends to submit a revised report in reply comments. [DPU] requests the [PSC] require [RMP] to provide a status report by July 30, 2020, on the Blue Sky Build program. Once [RMP] provides the revised report, along with a status report of the Blue Sky Build program, [DPU] recommends the [PSC] acknowledge the 2019 Blue Sky Annual Report." On May 12, 2020, RMP filed the requested information and on May 14, 2020 the PSC acknowledged the updated report as complying with the PSC reporting

requirements. In the September 24, 2020 comments accompanying the DPU's 2019 Audit Report of RMP's Blue Sky Program, DPU stated "During the [DPU]'s review we found [RMP] to be in general compliance with the rules and regulations set forth by the [PSC]. It appears the program follows good business practices and is using accounting and controls that are adequate and practical."

RMP filed its 2020 Annual Report of the Blue Sky Program (for the period of January 1 through December 31, 2020) with the PSC on March 25, 2021. This report is currently undergoing review. All documents related to this filing can be found at:
