Dear Ms. Saba:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) March 25, 2021 filing of its Annual Report of the Blue Sky Program for the period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 ("2020 Report"). The 2020 Report was filed pursuant to PSC orders in Docket Nos. 00-035-T01¹ and 07-035-T13.² The PSC also reviewed the April 21, 2021 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) and RMP's May 11, 2021 reply comments.

DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the 2020 Report conditioned upon RMP providing an updated 2020 Report that includes certain information related to Blue Sky community projects. DPU also requests that in future filings RMP provide other community project information, including whether a project serves a low-income/underserved community, and the percentage of Blue Sky funds awarded to each project. DPU states the 2020 Report substantially complies with PSC Orders and adheres to PSC reporting requirements.

In its reply comments, RMP filed an updated 2020 Report ("2020 Updated Report") as requested by DPU. In addition, RMP states it is agreeable to DPU's request for additional Blue Sky community project information going forward. RMP adds that while it is not always clear

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the degree to which projects may serve low-income or underserved communities, it will include information for each project when possible.

Based on the PSC's review of the 2020 Report, the 2020 Updated Report, and the filed comments, and DPU's recommendation, the PSC acknowledges the updated 2020 Updated Report as complying with the PSC's reporting requirements. The PSC adopts RMP's commitment to provide additional Blue Sky project details in future reports.
