The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) 2020 Annual Report of the Subscriber Solar Program ("Program") for the Period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 ("Report"), filed on March 25, 2021. The Report was filed pursuant to the PSC's October 21, 2015 Order Approving Amended Settlement Agreement in Docket No. 15-035-61 ("2015 Order").<sup>1</sup> The PSC also reviewed the April 26, 2021 comments provided by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU).

DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Report, and comments that RMP included elements in the report required by the PSC in correspondence dated August 16, 2017 issued in Docket No. 15-035-61 ("2017 Correspondence"). DPU further comments that the Program is 100% subscribed with a waiting list, its costs are lower than projected, and it is running better than expected.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and DPU's comments and recommendations, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with the reporting requirements in the 2015 Order and the 2017 Correspondence.
