Purpose

As part of the Division of Public Utilities' (Division) ongoing mission of protecting the public interest, the Division will be performing an audit of the DSM Program for the calendar year 2020.

Background

In 2020, RMP's portfolio include the following programs:

- **Energy Efficiency Programs:**
 - Wattsmart Homes
 - Home Energy Reports
 - Low Income Weatherization
 - Wattsmart Business

- **Peak Reduction Programs:**
 - Irrigation Load Control
 - Cool Keeper
 - Wattsmart Batteries (Effective October 3, 2020)
- **Other Portfolio Expenditures:**
 - Outreach and Communications

Issue

Annually the Division reviews various programs for compliance with state energy regulation and tariffs. RMP's DSM program was chosen for review at this time. The review will entail a sampling of invoices from the DSM 193 account for the twelve months ended 2020 and a review of the program administration.
