The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the June 1, 2021 filing by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) of its Utah Solar Incentive Program 2021 Annual Report ("Report"), submitted in compliance with the PSC's October 1, 2012 Report and Order in Docket No. 11-035-104. The PSC also reviewed the June 28, 2021 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU).

DPU asserts the Report contains the information required by previous PSC orders and correspondence, and adds that the information reconciles to that contained in RMP's Fourth Annual STEP Status Report filed with the PSC on April 29, 2021 in Docket No. 21-035-29.¹ DPU also identified the addition of Table 7, USIP Program Revenue Surplus Refund pursuant to the PSC's August 20, 2019 Order in Docket No. 19-035-T12, noting that the USIP Program Total Refund-to-Date of \$3.16 million exceeds the \$3.06 million refund amount approved in Docket No. 19-035-T12. Based on its review, DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Report.

Based on the PSC's review of RMP's Report, filed comments, and DPU's recommendation, the PSC acknowledges that the Report complies with the requisite reporting requirements.
