Dear Ms. Saba,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the 2020 Annual Cost of Service Study (COSS) model and exhibits filed on June 15, 2021 by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP). The filing was made pursuant to the PSC's May 29, 2014 correspondence in Docket No. 14-999-01. The PSC also reviewed the July 14, 2021 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU).

DPU states it reviewed RMP's 2020 COSS model and compared it with RMP's 2019 COSS model. According to DPU, the 2020 COSS model is materially the same in form as the 2019 COSS model, updated for RMP's end-of-year 2020 results of operations. DPU states it found no issues that warrant PSC action. Accordingly, DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge RMP's 2020 COSS.

Based on the PSC's review of RMP's 2020 COSS filing and DPU's recommendations, the PSC acknowledges that the filing complies with the PSC's reporting requirement.
