The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the Annual Demand-Side Management (“DSM”) Deferred Account and Forecast Report and Exhibit A (“Report”) filed by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) on November 1, 2021. RMP is required to provide the PSC an annual forecast of DSM expenditures, acquisition targets, and capacity and energy savings targets under the Phase I Stipulation approved by the PSC on August 25, 2009 in Docket No. 09-035-T08 and the PSC’s December 21, 2011 order in Docket No. 10-035-57 (“PSC Orders”). The Division of Public Utilities (DPU) and Utah Clean Energy/Southwest Energy Efficiency Project (UCE/SWEEP) filed comments on December 1, 2021 and RMP filed a December 16, 2021 reply.

DPU comments that it reviewed RMP’s forecasted surcharge, regulatory asset balance, program expenditures, and new offerings, and determined the Report complies with PSC Orders, recommending PSC acknowledgment. UCE/SWEEP recommends that in future forecast reports for the table “2022 Savings Forecast and Integrated Resource Plan Targets,” RMP move any non-incremental forecasted savings to a separate table to maintain consistency across the different measures and to enhance clarity. In its reply comments, RMP commits to discuss with the DSM Advisory Group how to report the forecasted Home Energy Reporting program savings in the future.

Based on the PSC’s review of the Report, DPU’s comments and recommendations, UCE/SWEEP’s comments, and RMP’s reply, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with PSC Orders.
