MOTION FOR EMERGENCY WAIVER OF JULY 1 FILING DATE AND REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R746-312-3(2) and R746-1-109, Rocky Mountain Power, a division of PacifiCorp ("Company" or "Rocky Mountain Power"), hereby requests and moves the Commission for an expedited order relieving the Company of the obligation to comply with the July 1 due date for its 2021 annual net metering and interconnection required by Utah Admin. Code R746-312-16(2). The Company requests a one-time waiver of the rule and an extension to file the report on August 6, 2021.

R746-312-16 requires the Company to submit an annual report to the Commission of certain information relating to the interconnection of customer generating facilities. In preparation for its 2021 filing, the Company discovered anomalies in the information in its records. The Company requests additional time to review the information before filing to ensure a complete and accurate report is filed with the Commission.

For these reasons, the Company requests an expedited Order from the Commission waiving Rocky Mountain Power's obligation to comply with the July 1, 2021 reporting deadline in R746-312-16(2).
