PACIFICORP 2022 ALL-SOURCE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS CODE OF CONDUCT

Definitions:

1. 2022AS RFP means PacifiCorp's 2022 All-Source Request for Proposals, which is the solicitation process that PacifiCorp will use to seek bids for 1,345 megawatts of new renewable wind and solar resources, filed in Docket UM 2193, Docket No.21-035-52, and Docket UE-210979 in Oregon, Utah, and Washington, respectively.
2. Benchmark Option or Benchmark Resource means any energy resource option against which bids in the 2022AS RFP may be evaluated that could be constructed or owned by PacifiCorp or an affiliate.
3. Benchmark Team or Bid Team means all employees and contractors of PacifiCorp or its affiliates who participate in the development of a Benchmark Option submitted or considered for submission in the 2022AS RFP.
4. Evaluation Team or RFP Team means all employees and contractors of PacifiCorp or its affiliates who are involved in the development of the 2022AS RFP or the evaluation and scoring of bids in the 2022AS RFP.
5. IE or IEs means the Independent Evaluator(s), who are third-party contractors not affiliated with PacifiCorp, that have been appointed by the public service commissions in Oregon, Utah, and Washington.
6. Screened means there must be no communication, no sharing of information, and no access to information, regarding the 2022AS RFP, by and between members of the Benchmark Team and members of the Evaluation Team.
7. Shared Work Groups means PacifiCorp employees that are part of the credit, engineering, compliance, permitting and safety, structure and pricing, and the portfolio optimization modeling (Integrated Resource Planning) teams who will be available to perform work for the Evaluation Team.

Conduct Requirements:

1. No member of the Benchmark Team may be a member of the Evaluation Team and the work and processes of the teams must be screened from each other. Members of the Shared Work Groups shall not share any information they obtain from the Evaluation Team with the Benchmark Team.
2. The names and titles of each member of the Benchmark Team and the names and titles of each member of the Evaluation Team shall be provided in writing to the IE.



3. The Benchmark Team shall make no changes to the Benchmark Option after the validation of the Benchmark Option by the IE and prior to the receipt of bids in the 2022AS RFP. The Benchmark Option will not be subject to change unless updates to all bids are permitted.
4. If a member of the Evaluation Team is contacted by a bidder or a member of the Benchmark Team, the Evaluation Team member shall direct the bidder or the member of the Benchmark Team to the IE and shall report such contact to the IE within seven business days.
5. The Evaluation Team will evaluate all bids and conduct all resource evaluations in a fair and non-preferential manner in comparison to any Benchmark Option, this includes all environmental risks and other weight factors. The Evaluation Team will apply the same assumptions, bid scoring, and evaluation criteria to Benchmark Options that are used to score other bids.
6. The Evaluation Team shall have no direct or indirect contact or communication with any bidder other than through the IE until such time as a final shortlist is selected.
7. The Evaluation Team may not disclose the contents or results of the 2022AS RFP or competing bids to the Benchmark Team prior to making such information public.


