Recommendation (Approve Tariff Sheets)

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") recommends that the Commission approve Rocky Mountain Power's ("Company") proposed changes to tariff 300 revising the carrying charge from 3.88 percent to 3.04 percent, with an effective date of April 1, 2020.

Discussion

On February 11, 2021, the Company filed revised tariff sheets to implement the annual carrying charge update. The Commission issued an action request, also dated February 11, 2021, to the Division with a due date of February 26, 2021. In response to the Commission's action request, the Division reviewed the filing and has determined that the proposed carrying charge of 3.04 percent was correctly calculated pursuant to the Commission's Order, dated February 27, 2017, in Docket No. 17-035-T02.

Conclusion

Based on the Division's investigation, the Division recommends the Commission approve the Company's revised Schedule 300, decreasing the carrying charge to 3.04 percent with an effective date of April 1, 2021.
