Recommendation (Approval)

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission) approve Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) proposed tariff Schedule No. 299 with an effective date of October 1, 2021.

Issue and Background

On October 1, 2021, the Commission issued its Order approving RMP's application as modified to reflect RMP's reply comments in the matter. On October 6, 2021, RMP filed its compliance filing for Electric Service Schedule No. 299, Billing for Other Entities, with an effective date of October 1, 2021. On October 6, 2021, the Commission issued an action request to the Division

requesting it to review RMP's tariff compliance filing and make recommendations. The

Commission asked the Division to report back by October 20, 2021.

Discussion

The Division concludes that RMP's compliance filing for Schedule No. 299 contains the

modifications RMP agreed to in its reply comments and establishes an effective date of October

1, 2021, as directed.

In review of RMP's advice letter for this matter, the Division reviewed Utah Administrative

Code R746-405-2(D)(3)(g), which requires a statement that the tariff sheets proposed do not

constitute a violation of state law or Commission rule. The filing does not appear to violate

statute or rule.

Conclusion

The Division has reviewed RMP's Electric Service Schedule No. 299, Billing for Other Entities,

compliance filing, and concludes that RMP's filing is just and reasonable and in the public

interest. The Division recommends the Commission approve RMP's proposed Electric Service

Schedule No. 299 with an effective date of October 1, 2021.
