The Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) October 6, 2021 Tariff Compliance Filing ("Filing") of tariff sheets creating Electric Service Schedule No. 299, Billing for Other Entities ("Schedule 299"). RMP submitted the Filing in compliance with the PSC's October 1, 2021 Order ("Order") in this Docket. The proposed Schedule 299 tariff sheets included in the Filing are consistent with those attached to RMP's September 22, 2021 reply comments, revised to reflect an effective date of October 1, 2021, and RMP attests that the proposed tariff sheets do not constitute a violation of state law or PSC rule.

The PSC also reviewed the October 18, 2021 comments submitted by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). In its comments, DPU states the Filing complies with the PSC's Order and Utah Admin. Code R746-405-2(D), and is just and reasonable and in the public interest. DPU recommends the PSC approve the proposed Schedule 299 tariff sheets with an effective date of October 1, 2021.

Based on the PSC's review of RMP's Filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves RMP's proposed Schedule 299 tariff sheets, effective October 1, 2021.
