Re: *Rocky Mountain Power's Filing in Compliance with the PSC's Order Issued on December 20, 2021 in Docket No. 20-035-34, Application of Rocky Mountain Power for Approval of Electrical Vehicle Infrastructure Program; Docket No. 21-035-T15*

Dear Ms. Saba:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) December 22, 2021 Compliance Tariff Filing proposing revisions to Tariff P.S.C.U. No. 51, and its January 12, 2022 Corrected Compliance Tariff Filing (as corrected, "Tariff Revisions") filed in compliance with the PSC's December 20, 2021 Order Approving Settlement Stipulation in Docket No. 20-035-34 ("Order"). The Tariff Revisions introduce original Tariff Sheet Nos. 60.1 and 60.2 that establish rates and conditions for Electric Service Schedule No. 60, Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Program (EVIP), and original Tariff Sheet Nos. 198.1 and 198.2 that establish an EVIP cost adjustment. The Tariff Revisions also include pertinent revisions to Tariff Sheet Nos. B, B.1, 2E.3, 80, 120.2, and 120.3. RMP attests that the Tariff Revisions do not constitute a violation of state law or PSC rule.

The PSC also reviewed the December 30, 2021 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). DPU comments that RMP's originally filed Schedule No. 120.3 contains a termination date that is different than the termination date set forth in the Settlement Stipulation adopted by the Order. RMP's January 12, 2022 Corrected Compliance Tariff Filing uses the termination date that DPU advises accords with the Order. DPU recommends the PSC approve the Tariff Revisions, subject to the correction, with an effective date of January 1, 2022. As corrected, DPU states the Tariff Revisions comply with the PSC's Order and Utah Admin. Code R746-405-2(D), are just and reasonable, and are in the public interest.

Based on the PSC's review of the Tariff Revisions and DPU's comments and recommendations, the PSC approves RMP's proposed Tariff sheets as corrected by RMP's January 12, 2022 filing.
