The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Dixie Escalante Rural Electric Association, Inc.'s ("Dixie Power") December 9, 2021 filing of its 2021 Compliance Report of the 2020-2023 Wildland Fire Protection Plan (WFPP) for Dixie Power, Including Flowell Electric Association, Inc. ("Report"). The Report details Dixie Power's efforts in implementing its WFPP filed on June 29, 2020¹ pursuant to Utah Code Title 54, Chapter 24, Wildland Fire Planning and Cost Recovery Act ("Act"). Dixie Power's Report documents its rebuilding of lines in high fire risk areas and replacement of unstable poles with steel poles. The PSC also reviewed the December 22, 2021 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU).

DPU recommends that the PSC acknowledge that the Report complies with Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(4)(b). DPU comments that it reviewed the Report and that Dixie Power's Board of Directors reviewed and approved the Report on December 8, 2021.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and on DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(4)(b). The Report is available for public inspection at the PSC website.
