On February 12, 2021, Dixie Power ("Dixie") filed proposed revisions to its tariff ("Revisions") to be effective April 1, 2021.

On February 26, 2021, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed an Action Request Response ("DPU's Response"), representing Dixie failed to notify its customers of the proposed Revisions. Citing Utah Code Ann. § 54-4-4.1, the DPU asserts the law required Dixie to hold a public meeting and to mail all members notice of that meeting at least 10 days prior. Based on Dixie's apparent failure to comply with the statute, the DPU recommends the PSC suspend the Revisions.

Dixie, or any other interested party, may file a reply to the DPU's Response on or before **Monday, March 8, 2021**.
