Dear Mr. Holdaway,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed tariff revisions filed November 1, 2021 by South Utah Valley Electric Service District (SESD) ("Tariff Revisions"). The Tariff Revisions, designated Tariff No. 11, document changes, including rate increases, to SESD Electric Service Schedule Nos. 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9. SESD submitted required redlined versions of the Tariff Revisions on November 10, 2021.

The PSC also reviewed comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on November 15, 2021. DPU comments that SESD notified customers of the Tariff Revisions, held a public meeting as required in Utah Code Ann. § 54-7-12(7), and that SESD's Board approved the Tariff Revisions during a public hearing held May 19, 2021. DPU further comments that SESD did not provide the PSC notice of the Tariff Revisions 30 days before their effective dates in compliance with Utah Code Ann. § 54-3-3. Nevertheless, DPU comments that no significant or material harm to SESD's members, the public, or SESD itself resulted from not following the 30-day notice requirement. Based on that reasoning, DPU recommends the PSC accept and acknowledge the Tariff Revisions for good cause, with an effective date of May 19, 2021.

Based on the PSC's review of the Tariff Revisions, and on DPU's comments and recommendations, the PSC finds that no significant or material harm to SESD's members, the public, or SESD itself resulted from SESD's failure to meet the 30-day notice requirement, and

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good cause therefore exists to acknowledge the Tariff Revisions. The PSC acknowledges the Tariff Revisions as complying with Utah Code Ann. § 54-7-12 and makes them available for public inspection.

Going forward, SESD should provide the PSC notice of any new or revised tariff schedule at least 30 days before its effective date to avoid any delays or additional administrative processes prior to PSC acknowledgment.
