The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Raft River Rural Electric Cooperative Incorporated's ("Raft River") October 27, 2022 filing of its Wildland Fire Protection Plan Compliance Report ("Report"). The Report documents the implementation of the Wildland Fire Protection Plan (WFPP) originally filed on August 11, 2020 pursuant to Utah Code Title 54, Chapter 24, Wildland Fire Planning and Cost Recovery Act. The Report provides an overview of operational protocols defined in the WFPP and includes the previous year's expenditures for implementing Raft River's WFPP.

The PSC also reviewed the November 23, 2022 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). The DPU states that the Report was approved by Raft River's Board of Directors on October 26, 2022 and recommends that the PSC acknowledge that the Report complies with Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(4)(b).

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(4)(b). Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(5), the Report is available for public inspection at the PSC.
