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In accordance with Utah Admin. Code R746-1-109, Rocky Mountain Power, a division of PacifiCorp (“Rocky Mountain Power” or “Company”) moves the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) to allow it to deviate from the electronic filing requirement in Utah Admin. R746-1-203(1)(b) for certain Filing Requirements submitted with the Application in the above-captioned matter. Utah Admin. Code R746-1-203(5) requires a party to file a motion to deviate along with a filing by disc if the party is “unable to use e-mail of the Commission’s SFTP server for electronic filing.”

The Commission should grant a motion to deviate when a rule imposes a hardship that outweighs the benefit of the rule. Utah Admin. Code R746-1-109. Specifically, the Commission was unable to open documents in the subfolder entitled “2021 Wind Outage Support CONF,” which the Company provided in the attachments to Filing Requirement 6-6, which was included with the Company’s filing on March 15, 2022. The Company and the Commission coordinated

and troubleshooted the issue, but were unable to resolve it. Therefore, the Company will hand-deliver a disc with these documents to the Commission.

The Company respectfully requests that the Commission grant the motion to deviate and accept the disc as a substitute for the “2021 Wind Outage Support CONF” subfolder.


