The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) March 24, 2022 filing of its Annual Report of the Blue Sky Program ("Program") for the period of January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021 ("Report"). The PSC also reviewed the April 5, 2022 comments provided by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU).

DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Report. In making the recommendation DPU states that the Report complies with the PSC Orders in Docket Nos. 00-035-T01¹ and 07-035-T13.² Additionally, DPU asserts the uncommitted funds balance did not decrease from 2021 contrary to RMP's indication that the increase in block size and REC prices would lower the fund amount. DPU states it will provide additional comments on this in its upcoming audit.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report, and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with the reporting requirements.
