The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's 2021 Annual Report of the Subscriber Solar Program ("Program") for the period of January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021 ("Report"), filed on March 24, 2022. The PSC also reviewed the April 25, 2022 comments provided by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU).

DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Report. In making the recommendation, DPU states that the Program continues to be fully subscribed with a customer waitlist. Additionally, the DPU reports a decrease in the liability account from \$1,940,715 to \$1,921,232.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with the October 21, 2015 Order Approving Amended Settlement Agreement and August 16, 2017 Correspondence in Docket No. 15-035-61.¹
