Rocky Mountain Power's Fifth Annual Sustainable Transportation and Energy Plan Act ("STEP") Program Status Report
Request for Date Change

On April 29, 2022, Rocky Mountain Power ("Company") filed its final annual report of the Sustainable Transportation and Energy Plan ("STEP") pilot program. In the cover letter that accompanied the report, the Company notified the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") of its intent to convene a stakeholder input meeting to discuss the final close out activities associated with the STEP pilot program and requested the Commission issue a public notice to allow interested parties the opportunity to make themselves known to the Company in order to be included in the stakeholder process. On July 21, 2022, the Commission issued an Acknowledgment Letter setting the STEP stakeholder meeting for August 2, 2022. The Company is in the process of gathering and compiling final information and respectfully requests the Commission allow for additional time so that the meeting materials can be finalized and provided to the stakeholders with sufficient time for review in advance of the stakeholder meeting. The Company has contacted the Division of Public Utilities and Office of Consumer Services and selected September 8, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. as a preferred date for the stakeholder meeting. The Company requests the Commission reschedule the August 2, 2022 meeting to September 8, 2022, and issue a public notice that instructs interested parties to contact Jana Saba, Regulatory Affairs Manager, at jana.saba@pacificorp.com by August 26, 2022 to be included in the distribution list for the meeting invite and meeting materials.

The Company plans to make a filing in the original STEP proceeding, Docket No. 16-035-36, by September 30, 2022 that will inform the Commission of the outcome of the stakeholder input meeting and will include requests for Commission approval to implement close out activities including refunds of surplus STEP and Utah Solar Incentive Program funds.

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The Company appreciates the Commission's assistance in this matter.


