The Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's January 1 – December 31, 2021 Service Quality Review Report ("Report") filed on April 29, 2022.

The Division of Public Utilities (DPU) submitted comments on May 24, 2022 recommending the PSC acknowledge the Report. DPU asserts the Report complies with the June 11, 2009 Order in Docket No. 08-035-55, and the December 20, 2016 Order in Docket Nos. 13-035-01 and 15-035-72. Additionally, DPU states RMP's filing complies with the requirements of Utah Admin. Code R746-313 – *Electrical Service Reliability*. DPU also concludes that the 2021 SAIDI and SAIFI values comply with the metrics approved by the PSC in Docket No. 20-035-22 Orders issued June 23, 2020 and January 26, 2021.

Based on the PSC's review, DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with PSC orders, rules, requirements, and procedures.
