Recommendation (Request for Extension)

On May 27, 2022, the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") issued an Action Request to the Division of Public Utilities ("Division") to review Rocky Mountain Power's Affiliated Interest Report for the calendar year 2021 with a due date of June 27, 2022.

The Division is in the process of determining and requesting the information necessary to comply with the Commission's request and finds that additional time will be required to complete this review.
