The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the Semi-Annual Demand-Side Management (“DSM”) Forecast Report and Exhibit A (“Report”) filed by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) on July 1, 2022. RMP is required to provide the PSC an annual forecast of DSM expenditures, acquisition targets, and capacity and energy savings targets under the Phase I Stipulation approved by the PSC on August 25, 2009 in Docket No. 09-035-T08 (“Order”). Exhibit A is an accounting analysis, reflecting actual results through May 2022 and projected results through December 2030. RMP indicates that the Schedule 193 collections surcharge rate of 3.56% is estimated to remain flat through 2024 and does not intend to propose a mid-year rate adjustment to Schedule 193 at this time.

The Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed comments on July 28, 2022, and no other comments were filed. Based on its review, DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the DSM Report as compliant with the Order.

Based on the PSC’s review of the Report and DPU’s comments and recommendations, the PSC acknowledges that the Report complies with the Order.
