On June 27, 2023, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) submitted its 2022 Annual Report ("DPU's Report") regarding the Home Electric Lifeline Program ("Program").

The PSC requests Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) submit comments regarding DPU's Report. Specifically, the PSC asks RMP address DPU's concern "some of the goals and measures failed to meet their respective standards" and conclusion that DPU's evaluation is, therefore, "inconclusive in terms of the success and effectiveness of the [P]rogram."¹

The PSC asks RMP submit its comments by **Wednesday, August 9, 2023**. Any other interested person may submit comments on DPU's Report on or before the same date. RMP and any other interested person may submit reply comments on or before **Thursday, August 24, 2023**.
