On July 30, 2021, the Company filed comments recommending the surcharge under Schedule 91 be set to zero for a period of five months, from October 1, 2021 through February 28, 2022, to reduce the balance of the home electric life program balancing account. As it committed in comments, the Company has monitored the balance and continues to believe that the five-month moratorium of the Schedule 91 surcharge will be sufficient to reduce the surplus balance. The account balance can continue to be monitored by the Company and interested parties through the Company's low-income lifeline reports that are filed twice per year at the end of January and July.
