Re: Docket No. 22-035-T03, In the Matter of Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Tariff

Revisions to Electric Service Schedule No. 300, Regulation Charges.

Recommendation (Approve Tariff Sheets)

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") recommends that the Commission approve Rocky Mountain Power's ("Company") proposed changes to tariff 300 revising the carrying charge from 3.04 percent to 3.05 percent, with an effective date of April 1, 2022.

Discussion

On February 1, 2022, the Company filed revised tariff sheets to implement the annual carrying charge. The Commission issued an action request to the Division with a due date of February 15, 2022. In response to the Commission's action request, the Division has reviewed the filing and determined that the proposed carrying charge of 3.05 percent was correctly calculated pursuant to the Commission's Order, dated January 20, 2016, in Docket No. 15-035-69.



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Conclusion

Based on the Division's investigation, the Division recommends the Commission approve the Company's revised Schedule 300, increasing the carrying charge from 3.04 to 3.05 percent with an effective date of April 1, 2022.
