Tariff Compliance Filing

On May 18, 2022, the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") issued an Order Approving Electric Service Agreement in Docket No. 21-035-69 ("Order"). In the Order, the Commission directed that the energy services agreement would be subject to Electric Service Schedule 198 – Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Program Cost Adjustment ("Schedule 198"). Rocky Mountain Power (the "Company") hereby submits a compliance tariff filing to modify Schedule 198 according to the Order. The rate of 0.27% reflected on Schedule 198 for Contract 1 is consistent with the rate used for Electric Service Schedule No. 9 – General Service High Voltage.

Enclosed for filing is a revised page associated with Tariff P.S.C.U No. 51 of Rocky Mountain Power applicable to electric service in the State of Utah. Pursuant to the requirement of Rule R746-405-2(D), the Company states that the proposed tariff sheet does not constitute a violation of state law or Commission rule. The tariff sheet reflects an effective date of May 18, 2022, for these changes which is the date the Order was issued.




