**Re:** **Docket No. 22-035-T07**, Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Tariff Changes to Electric Service Schedule No. 198 – Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Program (EVIP) Cost Adjustment.

## Recommendation (Approve Tariff Sheets)

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") recommends the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") approve Rocky Mountain Power's ("RMP") proposed tariff change to Electric Service Schedule No. 198.

## Issue

On June 2, 2022, RMP filed a Tariff Compliance Filing with the Commission to modify Schedule 198. The proposed change will apply the 0.27% rate to Contract 1 effective May 18, 2022, in compliance with the Commission Order in Docket No. 21-035-69. The Commission issued an Action Request on June 3, 2022, requesting the Division review for tariff compliance. This memorandum represents the Division's response.

## **Discussion**

RMP and Nucor Steel – Utah/Nucor Corporation (“Nucor”) negotiated a new Electric Service Agreement (“ESA”) that was approved by the Commission on May 18, 2022.<sup>1</sup> RMP represented in testimony supporting the ESA that Nucor will be subject to the new Schedule 198.<sup>2</sup> The Commission’s order identified and confirmed the ESA is subject to Schedule No. 198.<sup>3</sup> This tariff filing is to comply with the Commission Order.

## **Conclusion**

The Division recommends the Commission approve RMP’s proposed tariff sheets with an effective date of May 18, 2022.
