Application of Rocky Mountain Power for Approval of Electric Service Agreement Between PacifiCorp and Nucor-Plymouth Bar Division, a Division of Nucor Corporation; Docket No. 21-035-69

Dear Ms. Saba,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the June 2, 2022 filing by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) proposing modifications to Electric Service Schedule No. 198 – Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Program Cost Adjustment, Sheet No. 198.2.

The Division of Public Utilities (DPU) submitted comments June 13, 2022 recommending the PSC approve the proposed changes to Sheet No. 198.2 as filed, with an effective date of May 18, 2022. DPU asserts that the Electric Service Agreement between RMP and Nucor Steel – Utah/Nucor Corporation is subject to the new Schedule 198.<sup>1</sup>

Based on the PSC's review of the filing, and DPU comments, the proposed modification to Electric Service Schedule Sheet No. 198.2 is approved, effective May 18, 2022.
