Dear Mr. Laub,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Dixie Power's December 7, 2022 filing of its Wildland Fire Protection Plan Compliance Report ("Report"). The Report documents the implementation of Dixie Power's Wildland Fire Protection Plan originally filed on June 21, 2020.¹ The plan was filed pursuant to Utah Code Title 54, Chapter 24, Wildland Fire Planning and Cost Recovery Act ("Act"). The Report documents rebuilding of lines and replacing poles in Millard and Washington counties.

The PSC also reviewed the December 27, 2022 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). DPU states Dixie Power's Board of Directors reviewed and accepted the Report on November 2, 2022 and recommends that the PSC acknowledge the Report complies with Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(4)(b).

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(4)(b). Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(5), the Report is available for public inspection at the PSC.
