The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's 2022 Annual Report of the Subscriber Solar Program ("Program") for the January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022 period ("Report"), filed on March 28, 2023. The PSC also reviewed the April 25, 2023 comments provided by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU).

DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Report. In making the recommendation, DPU states the Program continues to be fully subscribed with a customer waitlist. Additionally, DPU reports a decrease in the liability account from \$1,921,232 to \$1,866,628.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with the October 21, 2015 Order Approving Amended Settlement Agreement and August 16, 2017 correspondence in Docket No. 15-035-61.¹
