Dear Mr. Parker,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed the October 12, 2023 audit report ("Audit Report") filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) describing DPU's findings related to its audit of Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) Blue Sky Program ("Program") for the January 1, 2023 – December 31, 2023 period. No other comments were filed.

The Audit Report states that DPU reviewed RMP's reported Program revenues and expenses for the year ended December 2022 and evaluated the Program's compliance with relevant PSC orders and tariff schedules. DPU states that the Program's revenues, disbursements, and expenditures appear to be properly stated and RMP appears to comply with the Program's regulatory and reporting requirements. Based on its findings, DPU comments that the Program appears to follow good business practices and uses adequate and practical accounting and controls.

The PSC appreciates DPU's Audit Report and DPU's efforts to ensure the Program complies with PSC orders and in accordance with Schedules 70 and 72.
