The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the May 22, 2023 filing by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) of its Utah Solar Incentive Program (USIP) 2023 Annual Report ("Report"), submitted in compliance with the PSC's October 1, 2012 Report and Order in Docket No. 11-035-104. The Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed comments on June 21, 2023 ("DPU Comments"), and no other comments were filed.

DPU comments that the 2023 USIP Report, as filed, reconciles to the information contained in the final STEP Annual Status Report that RMP filed on April 29, 2022 in Docket No. 22-035-13. DPU indicates the 2023 Report includes the estimated remaining USIP surplus funds of \$865,677 through 2023, \$192,930 of which has already been refunded during January through March 2023.² According to DPU, there are no expected administrative or incentive expenditures reported for the remainder of 2023 or 2024. DPU states that RMP expects the Program will show a zero balance by the end of 2023, and recommends acknowledgement.³

¹ In its October 1, 2012 Order, in Docket No. 11-035-104, the PSC ordered RMP to file an annual report of the USIP Program to include: the number of applications, the number and size of completed installations, the total installed costs of all completed installations, generation data for large systems, and the number, if any, of surrendered deposits. The Order also provides for interested parties a thirty-day comment period following the Report's filing to comment on its content and any associated recommendations made by RMP.
