ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR LEAVE
TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL COMMENTS

ISSUED: September 20, 2023

On September 1, 2023, the Office of Consumer Services (OCS) filed a Motion for Leave to File Supplemental Initial Comments ("Motion"), attaching its proposed Phase II Supplemental Comments. OCS explains the supplement is appropriate because OCS received discovery responses without sufficient time to incorporate the information in OCS's initial Phase II comments. OCS further argues supplementing its initial Phase II comments facilitates Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) opportunity to review them and address them in RMP's reply comments, as opposed to seeing the material for the first time in OCS's reply comments.

RMP did not file a timely response or objection nor did any other party.
