

Dear Northmont Way (north side) resident,

Because of the factors listed below, the 15 homes on the north side of Northmont Way have been designated by Salt Lake City Fire Department as among the city's highest risk area for a wildfire that could result in significant loss of property. These factors include:

1. Proximity of downhill Gamble oak groves to residential property
 - a. Under certain conditions, Gamble oak can be highly flammable
 - b. Wildfires move more rapidly uphill
2. Proximity to areas of moderate/ heavy recreational use including:
 - a. Morris Meadows Shoreline Trailhead
 - b. BMX bike area
 - c. City Creek Canyon picnic sites

As part of Salt Lake City's Community Wildfire Preparedness Plan, Captain Scott Winkler and members of his crew at Fire Station # 4 (on Eleventh Avenue) would like to meet with the owners and/or occupants of these 15 homes to conduct a 30 minute, fire risk assessment of the property and to discuss the city's wildfire response plan. They would leave you with a list of recommended fire preparedness, prevention, and mitigation strategies for your property, and help identify public and private resources that may be available to help you pursue them.
