Regarding the first docket #24-035-04 asking for a 30% rate increase this seems very unreasonable due to RMP using energy balancing charge increases during certain periods. On my home bill this increased by as much as \$30.00 dollars for the last bill period. This represent a more than 20% increase for this month and may be higher in future months. This would also apply to docket #23-035-40 asking for insurance increases. Based on this energy balancing account I do not think the rate increase or rate payers paying for insurance is justified. I sincerely hope the rate commission will not approve either of these items based on RMP variable rate structure in securing additional revenue.
