Investigation of Rocky Mountain Power's Transfer of Assets and Customers to Hurricane City DOCKET NO. 24-035-03

NOTICE OF INVESTIGATORY DOCKET AND REQUEST TO THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC UTILITIES TO INVESTIGATE AND ADVISE

## ISSUED: January 11, 2024

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has learned through a customer complaint ("Complaint Docket")<sup>1</sup> that Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) sold distribution assets it owned in Washington County to Hurricane City ("City") under a written agreement, dated August 3, 2023.<sup>2</sup> The transaction closed on, or prior to, November 1, 2023 and affected customers were subsequently transferred to Hurricane Power. While RMP represented in the Complaint Docket that it sold the assets to the City and transferred the customers because the City intends to annex the area, the City had not annexed the area when the transfer occurred.<sup>3</sup> The PSC is concerned RMP and the City did not present an agreement to the PSC for approval, as Utah Code Ann. § 10-8-14 appears to have required under the circumstances.

While the PSC has no jurisdiction over the City, the PSC opens this docket to investigate RMP's compliance with applicable law as regards this transfer of assets and customers.

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The PSC asks the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) to investigate and submit comments to the PSC by **Wednesday**, **February 21**, **2024**, addressing whether (1) RMP violated any applicable provision of statute, administrative rule, or prior administrative order in relation to these events; and (2) advise as to any appropriate action by the PSC to ensure future compliance in the event RMP committed a violation.

RMP may submit a response to the DPU's comments by Thursday, March 7,

## **2024**.

After reviewing these filings, the PSC will determine what additional process, if any, is necessary and appropriate.
