DISCOVERY

Discovery turn-around times related to approval of the proposed test period shall be seven calendar days. Parties shall serve discovery requests and responses on applicable parties by electronic mail. In the event a document produced in response to

a discovery request cannot reasonably be transmitted by electronic mail, the party disclosing the document shall provide an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy).

NOTICE OF VIRTUAL HEARING ON TEST PERIOD

The PSC will conduct a hearing in this docket regarding RMP's application for approval of the test period on **Monday, March 4, 2024, beginning at 9:00 a.m.** The hearing will be conducted via Google Meet at the following link: (meet.google.com/kkc-vfod-fvg). All parties must have their witnesses in attendance and prepared to testify.
