Dear Utah Public Service Commission,

I am a retired resident of Ogden. I thank you for your recent action.

Thank you for supporting ratepayer interests in reducing Rocky Mountain Powerandapos;s rate-increase request in Docket No. 24-035-04.

You listened to Utahnsandapos; concerns and accepted public input via hearings and the written docket. Thank you for holding shareholders accountable for Rocky Mountain Powerandapos;s major contribution to increased wildfire risk in the U.S. because of coal-burning power plantsandapos; well-documented impact on a heating climate.

As you consider the additional coal and gas fuel costs Rocky Mountain Power is seeking to recover through Docket No. 25-035-01, please keep in mind that Utah is home to abundant low-cost clean-energy resources, including solar and geothermal, that have no fuel costs. Those renewable resources reduce our reliance on costly coal and gas plants and expensive market purchases. In addition, a recent Reuters analysis estimated that the coal plants operated by Berkshire Hathaway, including the Rocky Mountain Power fleet, cause up to 260 deaths and \$3.9 billion in medical costs every year. Please reduce Rocky Mountain Powerandapos;s requested cost reimbursements in recognition of its poor decision-making.

As you begin the utilityandapos;s Integrated Resource Plan process, I urge you to ensure that its planning prioritizes reliable, clean, low-cost resources, especially solar, wind, geothermal, and energy storage.
