Public Service Commission:

Please be advised that in docket 24-035-05 RMP filed Reply Comments on March 12, 2024, which is the last scheduled filing in the docket. That filing contained a proposed draft temporary master metering contract between the developer and prospective tenets/ratepayers. The contract is part of RMP proposed resolution to this issues raised in the docket.

The OCS became concerned about a indemnification clause in the proposed contract because it could be read as imposing significant financial risk on prospective tenets/ratepayers as a condition of obtaining electrical services. The OCS contacted RMP to discuss its objections and the OCS and RMP reached a tentative resolution to the OCS's concerns. Pending the agreement of the developer, RMP and/or the OCS plan on making an supplemental filing within the next week with the indemnification provision in the draft contract rewritten if the Public Service Commission has not acted in this docket before this time.
